

Working together starts with the initial discovery exercise, establishing a definitive picture of your current digital assets and connectivity needs.

We work through a five-stage process that ensures the safety and compliance of digital broadband technology. This tailored service can cover design and planning through to on-site activity and post-installation inspection and quality assurance, including our digital handover pack.

Our final assurance audit assesses the build and installation against exacting standards, ensuring the safety of residents and buildings. This fully transparent and documented process aligns with Golden Thread principles and provides a high-quality, best practice solution that you can have full confidence in.





We audit

The start and finish to every digital installation

Our work begins with a thorough discovery exercise, where we gather and collate a variety of information, status updates and reports on your building portfolio. Taken together with the digital infrastructure design and build reports, this provides a vital part of the blueprint that informs the final audit.

The final audit is undertaken by our team of independent inspectors, giving full transparency over the structural integrity of buildings and safety of residents. This service is delivered at zero cost to you: it is paid for by the telecommunications providers, who are required to cover any reasonable costs incurred as part of the digital connectivity delivery.

The initial discovery phase includes an account plan, so you better understand the considerations and challenges the installation raises. Following this, we can also help you develop a digital connectivity strategy, and design the digital infrastructure for your MDUs. The Complete Fibre service gives you the further option of a building to home digital infrastructure solution.

Whoever you choose to work with on your digital infrastructure design and installation, the CTG discovery phase supports an evidence-based approach. Post-installation we complete an independent audit, to establish that all works are safe, meet industry standards and are in accordance with the design.

Our digital handover pack meets Golden Thread principles and meshes seamlessly with your in-house systems, providing a detailed and clear asset record to underpin ongoing compliance.

The CTG audit approach has been developed in consultation with a group of landlords and housing associations, and significantly reduces risk for landlords and telecommunications providers alike.

Planning digital connectivity

Our Route Design service has it covered

Following the discovery phase we can work with you to develop a digital connectivity strategy, including digital infrastructure planning and route design for your MDUs.

We recommend the most suitable locations for digital infrastructure to come into and through buildings, up to the floors or landings where residents live. Communicating this process clearly to residents is vital, and we can also support you on this front.

Once the design for digital infrastructure is developed, strict administrative and quality assurance protocols need to be passed before the build phase (also known as installation) commences.

In keeping with Golden Thread principles, a digital asset record is maintained during the build, with route design details continually reviewed and adapted. This rigorous process means providers are fully accountable, and all work is carried out to the highest regulatory standards.





Complete Fibre

Complete Fibre, the independent installation arm of CTG Holdings, is a building to home digital connectivity service. It exists to improve digital inclusion for thousands of multi-occupancy and social housing homes including high-rise blocks, across the UK.

Complete Fibre does all of the hard work for telecommunications providers, creating the fibre optic infrastructure for up to four broadband operators to quickly, easily and safely plug in to the system within a building, offering digital connectivity choices to every resident in the block.

Simplicity and safety

This approach removes the need for multiple installations by different companies, reducing disruption for residents, CO2 emissions and wider environmental impacts. And having fewer installations protects building integrity and lowers the risk of fire, too.

The service comes to landlords at no cost: access to the fibre network is leased by Complete Fibre to telecommunications companies at a fair market rate.

Just as for any installer of digital infrastructure, the Complete Fibre solution is independently audited by CTG. We hold Complete Fibre to account against recognised national standards, in a fully transparent and documented process.


